GOLD STAR:

This is the highest award a member can obtain. The winner will be selected from the following items:

- A completed record book submitted by June 13th
- An application form due by June 13th
- An interview

To be considered you must apply.

Gold Star-The member must be at least 15 at the time of application and must have completed at least 3 years in 4-H, including the current year. To be considered you must apply.

JR. MISS AND MR:

This is the highest county awards for 12- & 13-year-old. The winner will be selected from the following items:

- A completed record book submitted June 13th
- An application due by June 13th
- An interview

I Dare You Award:

William H. Danforth's book, I Dare You, was first published in 1931. It is still considered one of the most influential books in the area of personal motivation. The book is published and distributed by the American Youth Foundation through its I Dare You committee. The I Dare You Leadership Award is not a contest or competition. High school principals and county agents are asked to select (or have a staff or committee select) nominees. The award recognizes excellence in character, well-balanced personal development, and potential for leadership. (Ages 14-18)
