Livestock Judging



We have a group of members who participate in many youth livestock judging contests. At these contests, there are four animals in a class that are placed, consisting of cattle, swine, sheep, and goats. This program is a wonderful way for kids to build confidence and improve their decisionmaking skills. They also learn about livestock production and life skills along the way. We will host livestock judging practices this Fall as time permits. Quality Counts

Quality Counts is required for major livestock show entry and must

be completed each grade level division:

Junior – grades 3-5 Intermediate – grades 6-8 Senior – grades 9-12)

It does not have to be renewed every year.

In order to be eligible for the GCYS, the exhibitor must obtain a **Quality Counts** Certification number by January 31, 2025.

This certification is obtained THREE SEPARATE TIMES; once as a Junior Showman, once as an Intermediate Showman and once as a Senior Showman.

OR

Exhibitors must attend an educational class organized and provided by the GCYSA on a TBD date and time. If not complete by the due date, exhibitor will pay \$100 and must complete Quality Counts within 7 business days.
